Now that we know it, let's really show it, darlin'

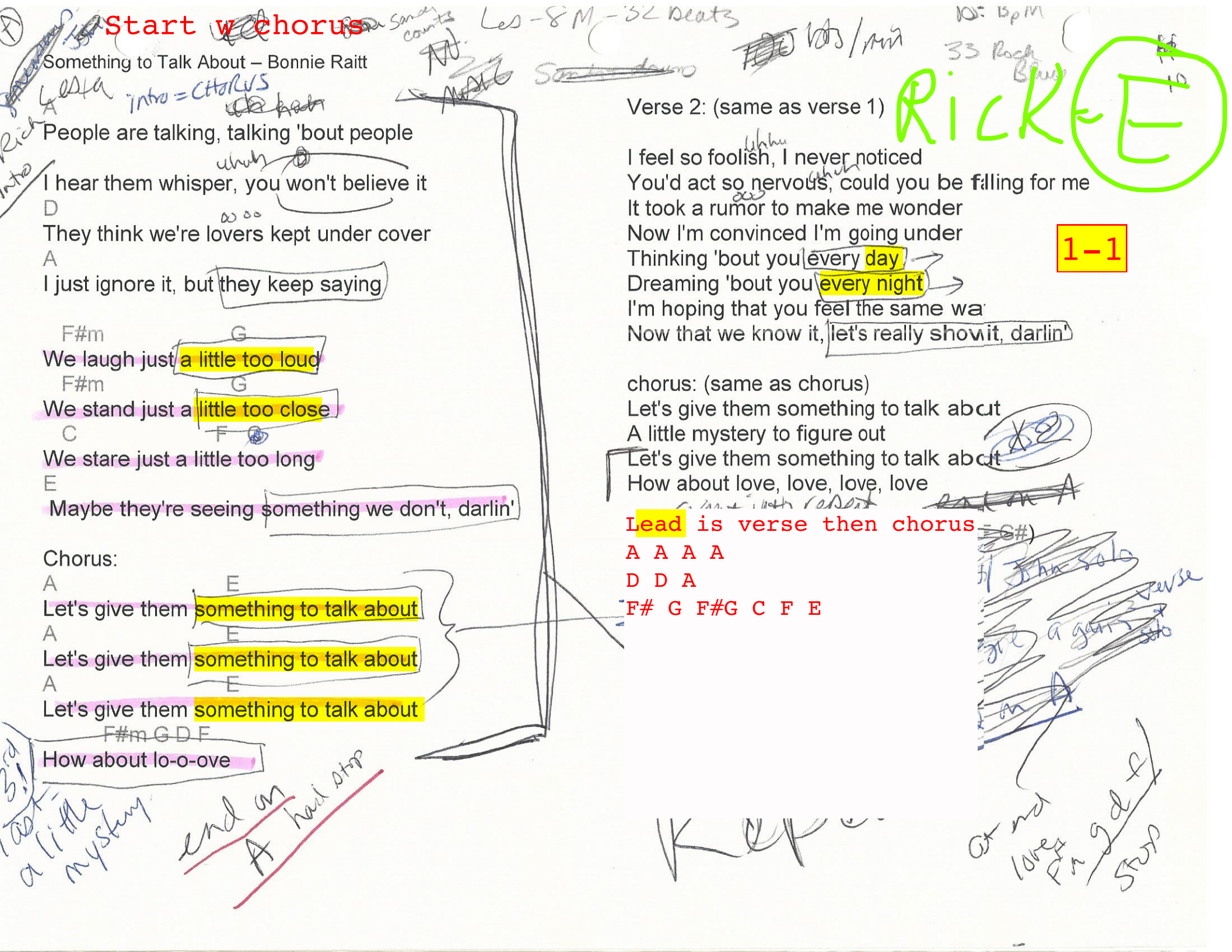
